June 13-17 Faces & Figures in Art by Mandy Rubino

June 20-24 Camp Invention: Spark Program

Join us on a *WILD* animal adventure, decipher some mysterious code, bounce through an atomic journey, get you game on in power play, and walk in Thomas Edison's footsteps by creating your own invention all in one week of camp! June 27-July 1 Hawaiian Paina

June 27-July 1 Columbus College of Art & Design Class

Campers spend half the day at CCAD. *Learn♥Grow♥Play* will provide activities before and after, as well as transportation each day.

Digital Art at CCAD \$250 5th & 6th graders Code: SJDA

This workshop will emphasize creativity, personal narrative, and fun. Students will learn how to compose successful images using photographs, scanned images, and Photoshop in CCAD's extensive computer imaging facilities. \$130 registration fee

Painting & Color at CCAD \$250 5th & 6th grade Code: SJPC

Students will learn basic painting techniques while completing still life studies in value and limited Chroma. Traditional and non-traditional techniques will be explored with acrylic paints and a variety of tools. \$130 registration fee

Graphic Novels @ CCAD \$250 7th-9th graders Code: SJGN

Students will learn about drawing the human form, composition, color, and serial narration while looking at popular comic book art from the past and present. Students will create dynamic comic books with action-packed illustrations and captivating characters. From traditional comics to modern anime to graphic novels, students will sample it all. \$130 registration fee

June 27-July 1 Rhythm Combo with Star Performance

For the budding young orchestra pit players, combining elements of chart reading and theory with improvisation and playing in a small group ensemble. With the exceptions of piano, all musicians should bring their musical instruments (keyboard, guitars, bass, drums, percussion, vocals, etc.). *Learn♥Grow♥Play* will provide activities before and after, as well as transportation each day. June 27-July 1 Combo: Rhythm Combo & Class at CCAD

Youth will be transported from the Pataskala United Methodist Church and go to Rhythm Combo camp at the Star Performance Academy. After lunch they will then go to Columbus College of Art & Design for the afternoon art class, which they chose. July 5-8 Celebrate America's Parks & Nature

Celebrate our country by learning about citizenship from Mayor Steve Butcher, exploring our country's nature by visiting Dawes Arboretum, Pataskala Park & Granville Parks, and enjoying some old fashioned American past times like a back yard barbeque, weaving and going to McDonalds. July 11-15 On Broadway – We've Got Talent

Everyone has a unique talent. Explore your talents in the visual and performing arts. Guest music teacher Susie Arnold will work with us musically. We will visit Bobbie's Dance Studio for an introduction to various dancing styles, and learn a step or two. Guest makeup artist Karen Sewell will help us learn about theater makeup, and we will explore our dramatic side. July 11-15 "Welcome to Theater" with Star Performance

Half of the day will be spent with Star Performance Academy giving your budding young actor the chance to learn elements of Basic Storytelling, Stage Movement, Character Development, and Pantomime, playing awesome theater games and putting together short plays and sketches. It's a great way to introduce kids to the basics of acting and using their imaginations on stage. July 18–Aug 6 Beauty & the Beast w/ Weathervane Playhouse
